
#### Join the R U OK? conversation

There is a sophisticated financial scam going around targeting international students at the University of Sydney and other Australian and international universities. The scammers have been posing as government officials, requiring that students transfer large sums of money to them with threats of deportation and imprisonment if they fail to cooperate. If you recieve a call like this, hang up the phone immediately and report it to ScamWatch.
