Your results will be emailed to your University student email account on Wednesday 14 December. After 24 hours, your results will then be available in Sydney Student. Find out more about result release.

If you're continuing your studies next year, <u>you'll need to re-enrol</u>. In Semester 1 2023, classes will be delivered on campus for onshore students. You'll only be able to select remote units (units with the location code 'RE') if you are studying offshore. <u>Find out more on our study information page</u>. You will need to have received all your results and been invited to re-enrol before you can select a unit in a January or February intensive session.


