Register with Inclusion and Disability Services for support in Formal Exams

If you have a disability or medical condition (temporary or ongoing) which may disadvantage you in your formal examinations, you may be able to access reasonable adjustments through Inclusion and Disability Services. To be approved for adjustments in your Semester 1 formal exams, you will need to register with Inclusion and Disability Services and book a consultation appointment with an Inclusion and Disability Officer by Wednesday 26 April.

The <u>census date</u> for Semester 1 is Friday 31 March. Double check your units of study, and
make sure you've submitted any HELP assistance forms and paid your fees. If you'd like
to <u>withdraw from any units of study</u>, <u>suspend your studies</u> or <u>discontinue your course</u> you'll
also need to do this by census.

Complete the Consent Matters module by Friday 31 March

As part of the University's commitment to safety all new students are required to complete the Consent Matters module. The module explores topics such as sexual consent, respectful relationships, and is compulsory for all students, regardless of your degree, age, or relationship status.
