Finalise your units of study by census date, Friday 31 March

Census date, this Friday 31 March, is the last day you will be able to finalise or withdraw from any units of study, finalise your residency status, suspend your studies or discontinue your course without it affecting your grades.

Please note that if industrial action goes ahead on Friday 31 March, the Student Centre will be closed for in-person enquiries, but will remain contactable online or over the phone. Check the notices page on Wednesday 29 March for confirmation of industrial action.

The Student Centre will remain open from Monday to Thursday this week for in-person enquiries.

Join the student feedback panel




