The scam involves victims being contacted on WhatsApp by scammers pretending to be legitimate electronic companies, such as Kogan and Dick Smith. The scammers then pressure the victim into transferring large amounts of money to a Crypto account or overseas bank account.

#### What to look out for?


- Being contacted on WhatsApp. This is not a legitimate way for companies to contact employees or recruit employees.
- Requests from electronic companies to transfer funds to a Crypto or overseas bank account. This is not a legitimate way for companies to receive funds.


## How we're helping provide costof-living relief for students
