Accessing your Semester 2 results

Your results will be emailed to your University student email account on Wednesday 13 December. After 24 hours, your results will then be available in Sydney Student. Check out our <u>guide to</u> <u>grades</u> to learn more about your results.

Changes to re-enrolment for 2024

We've recently changed how you can select units for the next year, meaning you get earlier access to selecting your units in Sydney Student. From 27 November, most students will be able to log in to Sydney Student and select their units.

 (<u>Student Discipline</u>) <u>Rule (pdf, 389KB)</u>. The Discipline Rule affects any student subject to


Network 4 Sustainable Nanotechnology


