APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **No separate application is required for the scholarship.**
- All eligible applicants holding unconditional offers by the specified cut-off date will be considered for the scholarship.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES

- Must not be in receipt of any other tuition scholarship or sponsorship administered by the University of Sydney.
- Must accept their unconditional offer of admission and accept the terms and conditions of the scholarship by the deadline specified in their scholarship offer.
- Must commence study in the semester for which the scholarship offer is made, and remain enrolled to receive their scholarship payment.
- Where students are found guilty of a serious misconduct or withdraws from the relevant course, the Scholarship will be terminated and the University reserves the right to be reimbursed for the funds paid to the Scholarship.
- May be asked to promote the Program in which they are enrolled as well as represent the University of Sydney at student orientation, marketing events and corporate networking events.

Secure an Unconditional Offer of Admission by the following dates:

SEMESTER ONE 2020

- Round 1 – 11 October 2019
- Round 2 – 06 December 2019
- Round 3 – 17 January 2020

SEMESTER TWO 2020

- Round 1 – 27 March 2020
- Round 2 – 24 April 2020
- Round 3 – 12 June 2020

Scholarships vary in value. Students may receive **A\$5,000, A\$10,000** or **A\$20,000** per student; and in the case of students commencing a Bachelor's degree, up to **\$40,000**.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Selection will be based on academic merit as assessed from the student's application for admission.
- Only international students commencing a CRICOS-registered Bachelor's degree or Master's by coursework degree delivered onshore face-to-face will be eligible.
- Selection committee consists of two nominees of the Executive Director, Global Student Recruitment and Mobility and one nominee of the Director of Admissions. The committee's decision is final.
